



Mandatory Interviews for Candidates from Countries with Higher Migration Risk for the Academic Year 2026/2027

1. Purpose of the Interview

In accordance with the Higher Education Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 56/25), FOŠ conducts mandatory interviews for certain foreign applicants before their enrolment application is processed.

The purpose of the interview is to verify:

- the candidate's identity,
- the authenticity and relevance of submitted documents,
- fulfilment of enrolment requirements,
- the seriousness of the candidate's intention to study.

2. Who Must Attend the Interview

The interview is mandatory for candidates who:

- come from countries with higher migration risk,
- require a visa to enter the European Union,
- submit an enrolment application to FOŠ.

3. Interview Fee

The candidate must pay the interview fee of EUR 250.00 within five (5) days after submitting the application and send proof of payment to: referat@fos-unm.si.

When making the payment, the candidate must provide:

- full name,
- residential address,
- postal code and country,
- the same email address as stated in the enrolment application.

If the payment is not made on time, the application will be rejected.

The interview fee is non-refundable, regardless of the interview result.

4. Interview Procedure

The interview is conducted online via MS Teams and takes place in English.



Before the interview begins, the candidate must identify themselves with a valid passport. During the interview, the candidate answers questions related to:

- the selected study programme,
- previous education,
- motivation for study.

If the candidate's identity cannot be confirmed or the candidate fails to attend the interview, the application will be rejected.

5. Interview Result

The interview result is valid only for the academic year 2026/2027.

The candidate will receive the interview result no later than three (3) working days after the interview.

Successfully completing the interview does not automatically guarantee admission. The candidate must also fulfil all other enrolment requirements in accordance with the call for enrolment.

6. Exception

Candidates holding a valid temporary or permanent residence permit in the Republic of Slovenia are exempt from paying the interview fee.
