FOS provides study programmes at bachelor, master's and doctoral level.

The bachelor study programme lasts for 3 years (180 ECTS), and is composed of compulsory courses, elective courses, practical training and a bachelor thesis.

The master's study programme lasts for 2 years (120 ECTS) and is composed of compulsory courses, elective courses and a master's thesis.

The doctoral study programme lasts for 3 years (180 ECTS), and is composed of a compulsory methodological course, compulsory seminars, an elective theoretical course and a doctoral thesis.

Doctoral School at FOS

is currently active in four different fields of study enabling prospective students to gain a PhD title in Quality Management, Development Management, Tourism Management and in Information and Communication Technologies Management.

The PhD study programme lasts for 3 years (180 ECTS) and is research-oriented with a limited amount of courses and a focus on individual scientific outcomes. PhD topics are agreed with candidates and can vary, based on the individual preferences.

Doctoral Degree in Quality Management

The study programme provides students with an in-depth understanding of theoretical and methodological concepts as well as the skills necessary for independent research or a professional career in the commercial and non-commercial sectors, and public administration.

Doctoral students of Quality Management do research in the field of quality management. Their study programme is defined by general study duties such as seminars, methodology and a field specific course which, together with the topic of their doctoral thesis, defines their title.

Prospective students of this study programme are expected to have a research interest in business processes, standardization, quality control and excellency of management. Their supervisors are academics with a long term experience in industry and organisation management.

Doctoral Degree in Development Management

Doctoral students deciding to pursue their PhD in Development Management are, next to the compulsory set of seminars and courses, attending the courses on topics of regional, sustainable, or development management, and doing the research in the same field.

Development Management is covering combination of the economic, managerial and political science. Prospective students of Development Management will have the ability and the interest in improving the local, regional, national or international social environment in order to improve the quality of life.

Their supervisors are coming from the internationally recognized institutions, such as Charles University in Prague, Bocconi University Milano and many others.
