REGIONAL GOVERNMENTS' FINANCING

Abstract

In this article I would like to emphasize a funding problem of governing authorities. After decentralization of public administration in 2001, governing regions were given a lot of new competences. There are two types of them. Firstly, there are powers which are carried out only by governing authorities. Secondly, when the state could not carry out some powers, it can transfer to a region or a village (town).
