

Dr. Daniel Klimovský je docent za področje javne uprave na Tehnični univerzi v Košicah (Slovaška) in na Palacky Univerzi v Olomoucu (Češka). Je ambasador Regional Studies Association na Slovaškem, ko-kordinator delovne skupine za Lokalne politike pri NISPAcee, član delovne skupine COST IS 1207: Reforme lokalnega javnega sektorja v Evropi, ter glavni koordinator iniciative POL-LOC, ki združuje 20 Evropskih visokošolskih institucij iz 15 držav. Od leta 2012 je član nadzornega odbora Open Society Foundation na Slovaškem. Od konca leta 2013 je zunanji ekspert Sveta Evrope. Je član odbora za lokalni razvoj mesta Košice ter sodeluje v združenju mest in skupnosti Slovaške. V preteklosti je bil tudi zunanji svetovalec slovaške vlade. Daniel Klimovský je avtor številnih znanstvenih in strokovnih publikacij.

Daniel Klimovský, Ph.D. is assistant professor of public administration at Technical University of Košice (Slovakia) as well as at the Palacky University in Olomouc, Czech Republic. He is the Ambassador of Regional Studies Association for Slovakia, Co-coordinator of the Working Group on Local Public Policies by the NISPAcee, member of the Management Committee of the COST IS 1207: Local Public Sector Reforms in Europe as well as main coordinator of the POL-LOC initiative that includes more than 20 European universities from 15 different countries.

Since 2012, he is member of the Steering Committee of the Open Society Foundation in Slovakia in 2012, and since late 2013 he has been independent/external expert of the Council of Europe. Furthermore he was cooperating with central government in Slovakia as external adviser, and he is member of the Local Development Committee in the City of Kosice. In addition, he cooperates with the Association of Towns and Communities of Slovakia. He is author of numerous scientific and professional publications.
