"European Union and post-Brexit economy"

Jean Monnet Chair, prof. dr. Uroš Pinterič invites interested experts to present their research in the field of post-Brexit development of the European Union at the announced workshop. The main question of the Workshop is future of the European Union in every, and especially economic perspective in the future years. Brexit, as such, had, has, and will have much more complex consequences as it is planned. However, closer we are approaching to the actual split, more it seems that the act itself is only shallow expression of change in European reality, connected to different fields, from policy-making, political development of the integration, etc. Brexit might, in the future years, in fact mean start of new spring of nations in the Europe, it can mean more social policy or just fiscal centralisation. 2017 White Paper on the future of the Europe indicates certain scenarios, which fulfil all bureaucratic, administrative, political and most of other criteria that options can be at least foreseeable. We can be sure, that European officials, on purpose, skipped at least one additional scenario, which is decomposition of the European Union. In this perspective we can understand Brexit as well as strengthened border control among certain Schengen countries two years after the migration wave, which was significantly reduced long time ago. Special attention shall be paid also to the political shifts in European countries, where right wing extremist populism is feed by the fear from the migration on one hand, but it has its roots in weak and dehumanizing economic and social policies.
